Welcome to the **212th's 200 CLUB**. A great way for you to support the 212th Glasgow whilst having a bit of a flutter! Here's how it works...

What is a 200 Club?

For those who've not come across one before, a '200 club' is a regular lottery, which is usually run for a charitable purpose, in this case the 212th Glasgow Boys Brigade. The 200 Club is defined as a 'private lottery' under the provisions of the Gambling Act 2005 Section 14.

Why should you join?

To help raise money for the 212th Glasgow and because you will have a good chance of winning one of the 24 cash prizes awarded per year!

What does it cost to join?

Each number costs £24 per year (£2 per month). There is no limit on how many numbers a person can hold.

How do I join?

Complete and sign the 200 Club membership form and pay £24 by cash or cheque, or complete the standing order mandate at the bottom – either £24 annually (preferably) or £2 monthly per membership. Each membership is allocated you a number, which goes into the monthly draw.

All participants must be over 16 years old, and can join the 200 Club at any stage during the year. The maximum permitted membership is 200.

When are draws made and what can I win?

On the first Friday of each month (for the preceding month's payment) from March to February, two numbers will be drawn, 1st and 2nd place prizes. The name of the winner and runner-up will be published on the 212th website and/or Facebook page and payment made by cheque or to your nominated bank account. The monthly prize fund is 50% of the money collected each month and is paid out in prizes of 1st-75% and 2nd- 25%. For example, if 200 numbers were bought by members, then the prize fund would be £200 and split as follow, 1st - £150; 2nd - £50. The actual value of the prizes will be proportional to the numbers sold. For the December (drawn in January) the prize fund will be 75% of funds collected.

The remaining 50% of funds collected goes to the 212th, to help fund its activities, equipment, resources and opportunities for boys.

THE 212TH 200 CLUB RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of The 212th 200 Club is to raise funds for the benefit of the 212th Glasgow Boys Brigade and to help fund activities, equipment/resources and opportunities for boys.

RULES

1. The 212 Club is defined as a private lottery under the provisions of the Gambling Act 2005 Section 14 and is open to all members, parents, supporters and friends of the 212th Glasgow Boys Brigade.
2. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
3. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 200.
4. An individual can purchase as many numbers as they wish.
5. Membership/numbers will be allocated numerically as and when membership forms are received.
6. A draw of eligible numbers will be made on the first Friday of every month with two prizes awarded.
7. The prize fund will total 50% of the total monthly income.
8. Prizes are apportioned as follows: 1st prize 75% of prize fund and 2nd prize of 25% of the prize fund. The prizes for the December draw will be higher with the prize fund being 75% of monthly income.
9. Payments must be made by cash or cheque (annually). Members can pay by standing order (monthly or annually). One month's notice is required for cancellation if paying by standing order.
10. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date. For those paying by monthly standing order, funds must be received in the 200 Club bank account before the last business day of the month.
11. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 200 Club if their subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month, and their number may then be sold to someone else.
12. The draw shall be made under the direction of the Trustees of the 212th Glasgow Boys Brigade, on the first Friday of the each month, for the previous month's membership.
13. Winners will receive a cheque posted to the address on the membership form within one week of the draw, or paid direct to their nominated bank account.
14. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the 212th website, & Facebook page. No other personal information will be disclosed.
15. The 212th 200 Club will be run by the Trustees of the 212th Glasgow Boys Brigade and its operation reviewed on an annual basis. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Trustees is final.
16. If a winner's cheque has not been cashed after a period of six months, the winnings will be donated to the 212th Glasgow Boys Brigade.
